# **Supervisor Development**

## **Master Trainer Programme at UVAS**

### **Introduction**

A baseline study was conducted to evaluate the current standing of Pakistan's Higher Education (HE) sector in terms of PhD supervision policies and practices. This study included a comprehensive review of previous capacity-building programs for doctoral supervision in Pakistan and an analysis of existing PhD policies, processes, and procedures compared to international best practices. Based on the findings, a training program was developed for 200 PhD supervisors in Pakistan, focusing on the best practices followed in the UK for PhD supervision. Of these, 140 trained supervisors were designated as master trainers who further cascaded the training to a broader audience of approved supervisors. Additionally, an advanced training program in the UK was offered to selected participants, focusing on running successful PhD programs in Pakistani Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). Participants for the UK program were selected through a competitive process to ensure the highest standards were met.

The following route of Supervisor training was followed.



## **Managing the Master Trainers' Programme**

1. Development of training and assessment on HEC and institutional rules and regulations for your institution
2. Draft implementation plan for supervisor development at your institution via Cross Institutional Groups (CIGs)
3. Co-creation of case scenarios the Pakistani context
4. Continue work with Reflection and Action Plan
5. Facilitation skills

## **The Points Focussed While Developing the Programme of Training**

1. Reflection on Experience and practice
2. Peer learning facilitated by experienced supervisors
3. Case Scenario promoting discussion and learning
4. Theories, Models and Tools for supervisors' were practiced

## Recommendations and Remarks by Master Trainers

1. In the preview of the workshop, 'Researcher Development Needs Analysis Questionnaire' which is globally adopted across universities, with notable implementation at Coventry University. We are keen to introduce and apply this form within our own institution to align with best practices for PhD supervision."
2. The faculty members trained through this workshop will be equipped to meet the standards outlined in the Eligibility Assessment Checklist for Approved Supervisors, which requires certification or training under the auspices of NAHE or HEI.
3. The training session was highly effective and well-organized, with facilitators demonstrating considerable effort. The module provided valuable insights into organizing and managing supervision and postgraduate research (PGR). The interactive nature of the session ensured that each participant was fully engaged in the activities, contributing to its overall success.
4. While the session was both informative and engaging, it would benefit from improved time management by the resource person. Additionally, incorporating more scenario-based activities could enhance the learning experience. Extending the time allocation for the module would also be advantageous.
5. Furthermore, there is a need for additional training for faculty members on the efficient use of AI tools. Overall, the session significantly improved my strategy for supervising students and enhanced my skills as a PhD supervisor.
6. We aim to expand this workshop by having master trainers from the University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (UVAS) provide training to M.Phil and PhD supervisors in other institutions. To achieve this, we seek the support and

collaboration of the National Academy of Higher Education (NAHE) to facilitate this initiative and ensure its successful implementation.

## **Upcoming Initiatives of the Workshop**

The Master Trainers from this workshop will further extend the training to over 100 faculty members within and beyond the institution throughout 2024. To sustain this ongoing process of capacity building, the Supervisor Development Programme will focus on the following key modules in 2025:

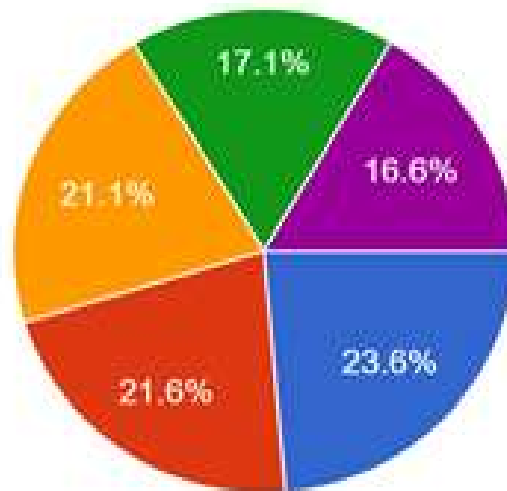
1. Identification of challenges in the recruitment and selection of PhD candidates in your institution and in the cross institutional groups.

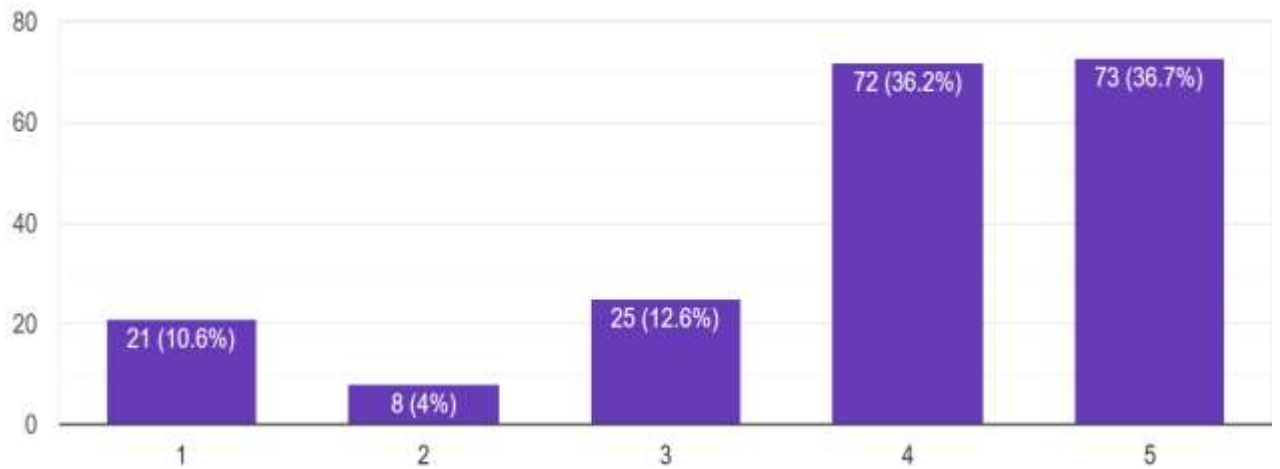

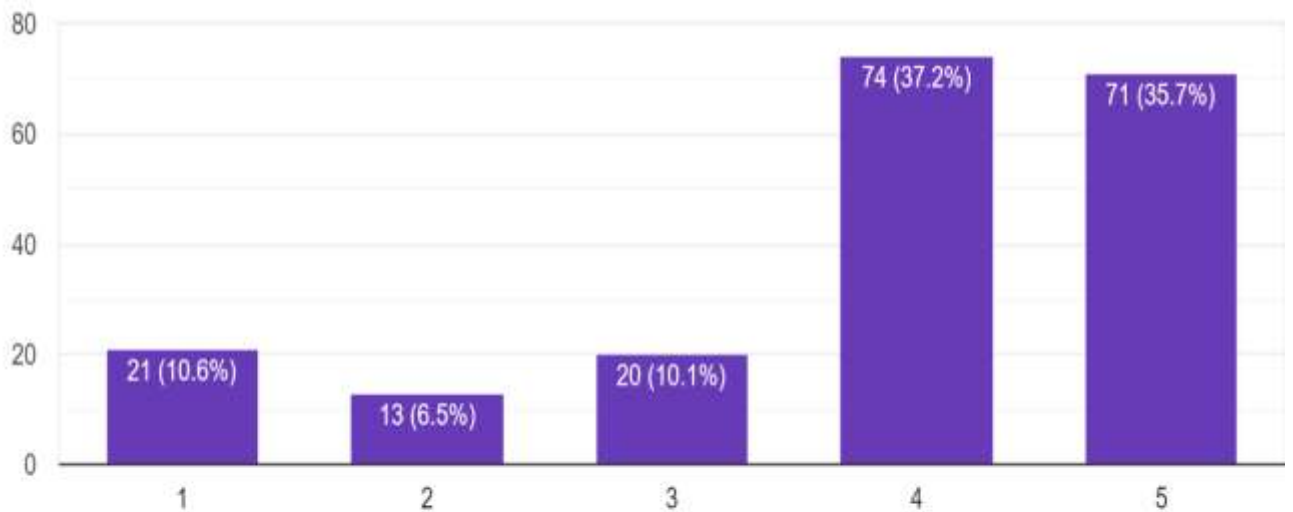

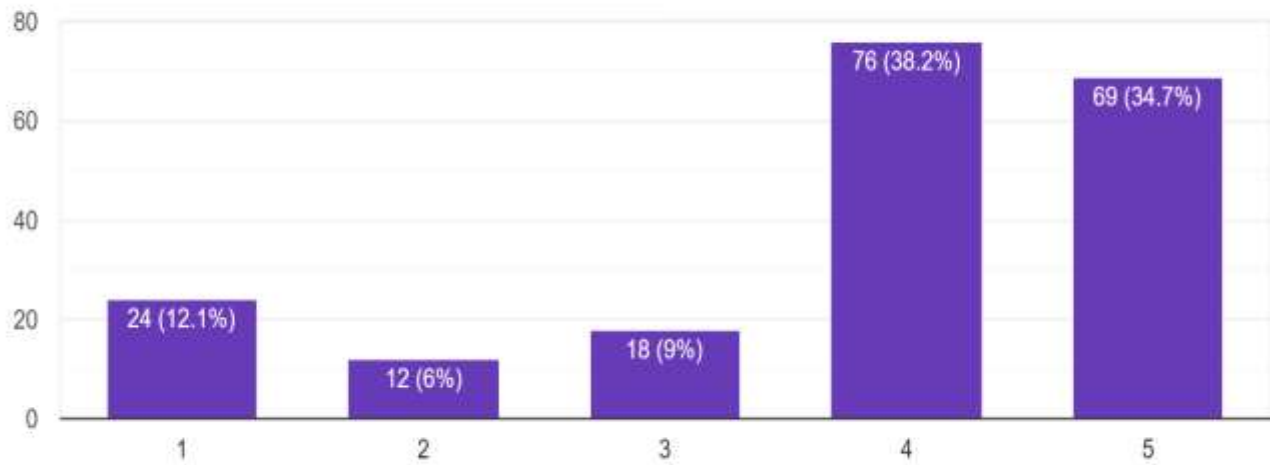

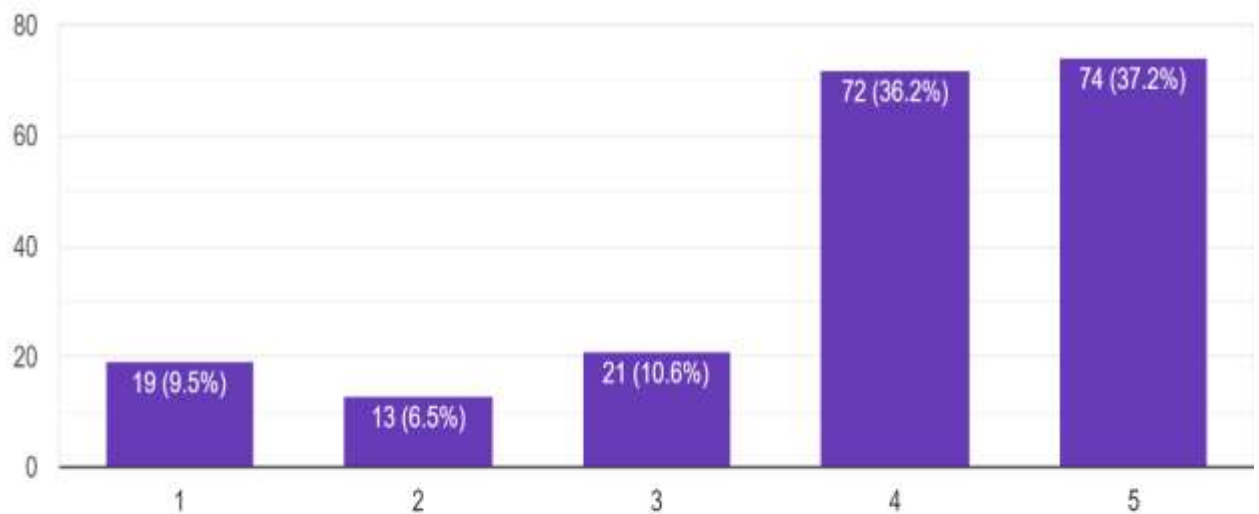

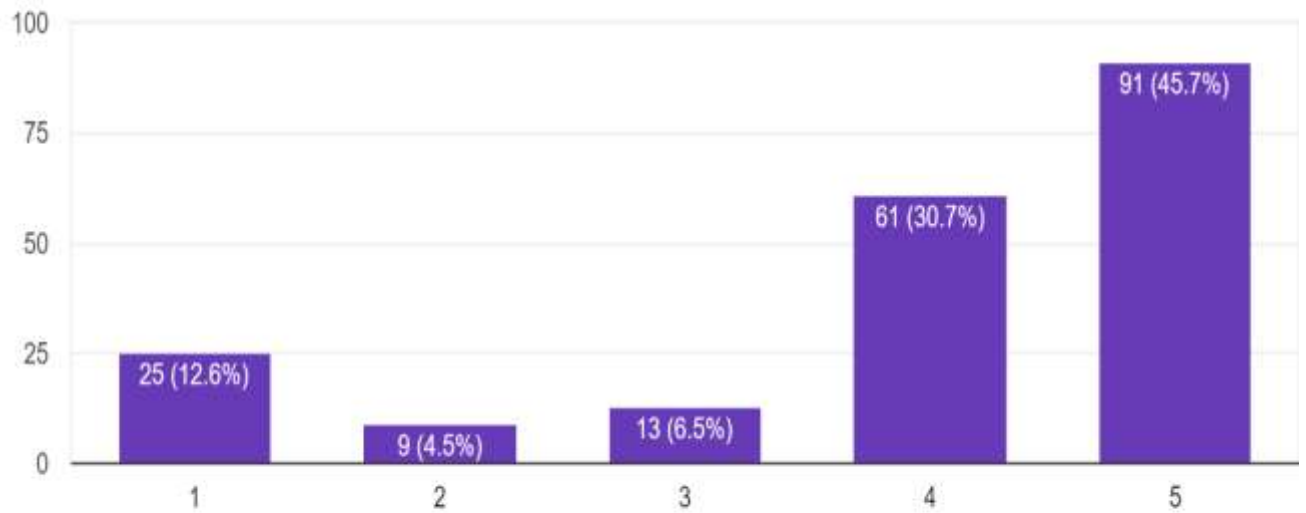

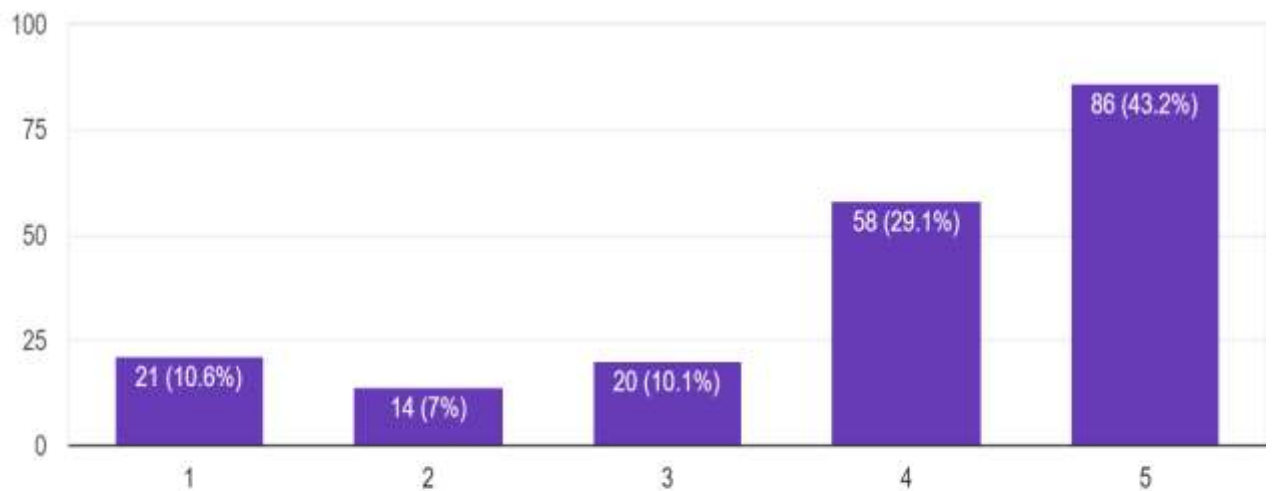

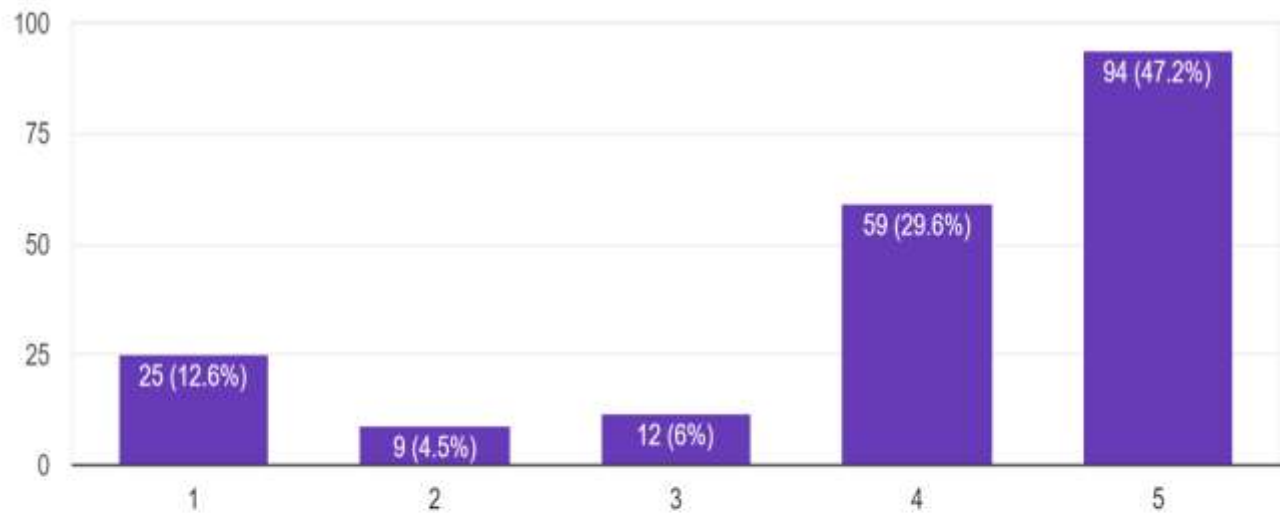

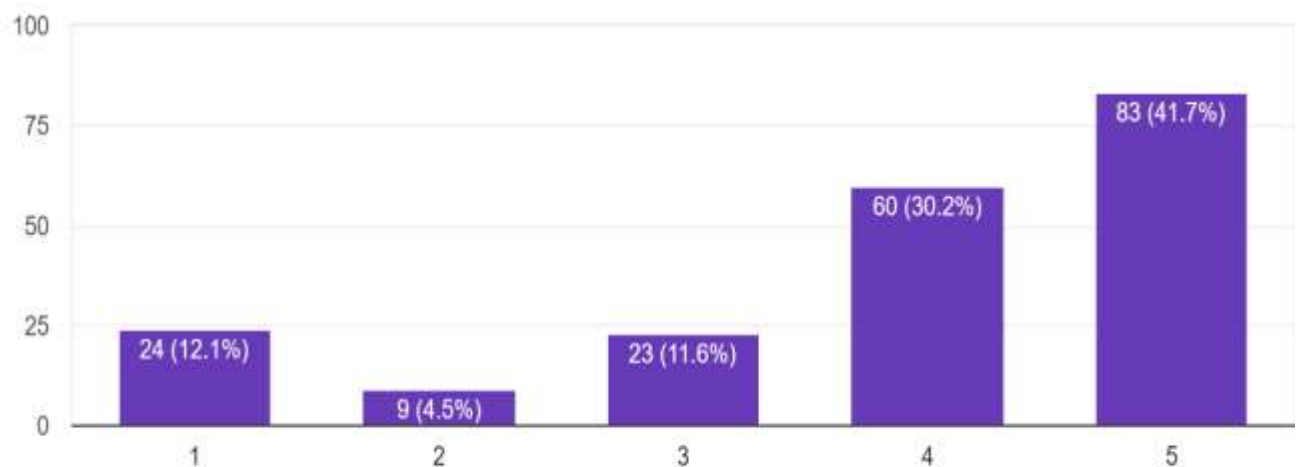

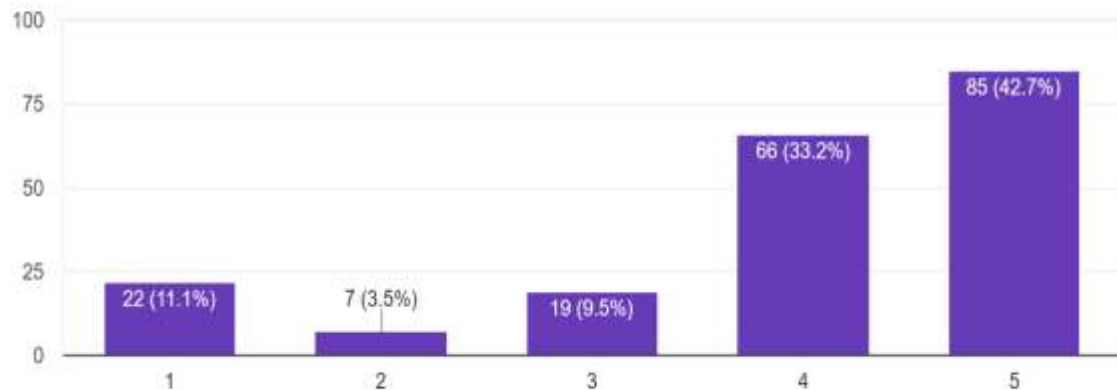
